




GATLINBURG America's Mountain Home







GATLINBURG TROLLEY SYSTEM



Hop aboard the Trolley - a fun and easy way to get around Gatlinburg. Four color coded trolleys make frequent stops along four regular routes around Gatlinburg 365 days a year. Visitors in the area can board a Trolley at any stop in

the City and be off to their destination. All Trolleys stop at the Mass Transit Center, located at Ripley's Aquarium of the Smokies. The Map in the center of this guide shows the Gatlinburg routes.

The Gatlinburg Trolley can also be used as an easy way to get into downtown without the hassle of driving into the City and finding a parking spot. You can use the free Park N Ride Lot at the Gatlinburg Welcome Center, located at 1011 Banner Road in Gatlinburg, just off of the Spur just before entering town, board a trolley and be in downtown Gatlinburg in a matter of minutes.

Operating hours can change seasonally, so be sure to check Gatlinburg.com/trolley for updates.

THE GREAT **SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK**



he Cherokee people called this the "Place of Blue Smoke", for the lovely bluish mist from which the mountain tops rise. Today, it's the most visited National Park in the United States. It's so big, scientists are

still discovering some of the plant and animal species that live there.

The park is home to more than 1,500 bears so keep your eyes open when hiking the Smoky Mountain trails. Nothing beats seeing a bear in the park, and there are plenty of other breathtaking sights here in the

Smoky Mountains waterfalls, winding valleys and century-old architecture.

Take a drive and feel your heart come alive. Early explorers may have had some of the first glimpses of the beauty of the Smoky Mountains, but only



after many weeks of difficult bushwhacking across treacherous terrain. Fortunately for today's visitors, Great Smoky Mountain National Park has paved the way (literally) for easy viewing of the Smokies' most prominent features and stunning views.



There's no wrong way to take in the extraordinary beauty of the Smoky Mountains, but to catch the close-up grandeur of Smoky Mountain waterfalls and endless forests means lacing up your hiking boots. Some of the most scenic hiking trails in Tennessee are found right here, winding through wildlife habitats and old-growth forests to the area's most popular sights.

Few experiences in nature are more rewarding than taking in the sights and sounds of a hike and knowing that majestic waterfalls and awe-inspiring vistas await you at the end.

Vacations are all about escaping the everyday, and nothing will remind you of that more quickly than spotting a bear or elk in the Smokies. Because Great Smoky Mountain National Park is a thriving black bear habitat, chances are good you'll catch a sight of these magnificent creatures, along with an incredibly diverse population of plant and animal species.


As of March 1, 2023, valid parking tags are required on any vehicles parking for longer than 15 minutes in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. All revenue will stay in the park to provide sustainable, year-round support focusing on improving the visitor experience, protecting resources, and maintaining trails, roads, historic structures, and facilities. Visitors who simply drive through the park do not need a parking tag. Parking tags are available for purchase in Gatlinburg at the Gatlinburg Welcome Center, located at 1011 Banner Road, as well as, Greenbrier Grocery, located at 2406 East Parkway in Gatlinburg. Tags are available for \$5 daily, \$15 weekly, or \$40 annually.



From breathtaking landscapes and mountain views to rivers and waterfalls, the environment and diversity of wildlife are a foundational part of the visitor experience in the Smokies. As stewards of the majestic Great Smoky Mountains National Park,

residents and businesses of Gatlinburg are committed to preserving the natural beauty and wildlife for future generations to enjoy.

Visitors often ask why there are no recycling bins in Sevier County. Sevier Solid Waste Inc. has created a world class recycling and composting facility that renders recycling bins obsolete. The plant successfully handles garbage generated by millions of visitors each year by separating organic waste from recyclable materials.

Food, paper and cardboard are placed in aerobic digesters and eventually become compost. Non-organic materials, like metals and plastics, are separated, cleaned and prepared for recycling.

The City of Gatlinburg has three beautiful City Parks and a Community Center available for use by residents and visitors. Each park has a children's playground, covered picnic pavilion and restroom facilities.

Mills Park

features sports fields, a 9-hole disc golf course and a NEW Dog Park!



Mynatt Park

newly renovated, the park features ADA compliant walking trails, new baseball/softball field, renovated basketball and tennis courts, pickle ball courts, green space, children-only fishing stream and plenty of picnic tables, as well as, the 2016 Wildfire Memorial.



Herbert Holt Park

newly renovated with improved river access, new playground, and improved parking.



Visitors are encouraged to take advantage of the **Gatlinburg Community Center**, a 52,000 square foot facility open to everyone, offering racquetball and basketball courts, bowling center, indoor swimming pool, an all-purpose fitness center and a variety of community programs.

The City of Gatlinburg operates a trout farm in order to stock city streams with trout year-round. Trout facility staff stock sections of the West Prong of the Little Pigeon River, Dudley Creek, Roaring Fork and **LeConte Creek every Thursday** which is the only day of the week when fishing is prohibited inside city limits.

Mynatt Park and Herbert Holt Park have river sections dedicated as children's fishing only. Children 12 and under can fish in the dedicated sections and are not required to have a Tennessee fishing license.

BLACK BEARS IN THE SMOKY MOUNTAINS

Black Bears are an iconic symbol of Great Smoky Mountains
National Park and a treasure to our community. While seeing a
bear is a wonderful experience, it's important to always be "bear
aware". Please review the following tips and information so you
know what to do if you encounter a bear in town or on the trail.

Black Bear Safety Tips

Bears are wild and their behavior can be unpredictable. Although extremely rare, attacks on humans have occurred, inflicting serious injuries and death. *Treat bear encounters with extreme caution!*

- Do not approach within 50 yards or any distance that disturbs a bear. Use binoculars or telephoto lens to view animals.
- Do not allow a bear to approach you.
- If you see a bear, slowly back away from the bear. Do NOT turn and run.
- Make sure the bear is aware of your presence by yelling and making noises to frighten the bear and encourage it to leave.
- Groups should stay together, especially children.
- Keep dogs leashed at all times. Don't let your dog harass a bear.
- Put all trash and food scraps in bear-resistant containers or take it with you. Be sure to close and latch tightly.
- Do not feed or place food to attract bears.
- Do not leave grills or picnic tables unattended.
- Do not leave food in your car or in coolers outside the cabin.
 If you must store food in vehicles, keep it out of sight.
- Completely close and LOCK all doors and windows of vehicles and buildings. (Yes, bears can open them.)
- Do not feed wildlife. Feeding a bear guarantees its demise!
